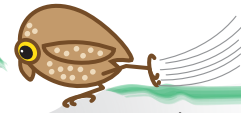


DIGBY ...the Burrowing Owl



They scratch and scrape to dig their burrows.



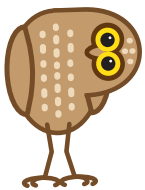
Burrowing Owls shelter and nest under the ground.



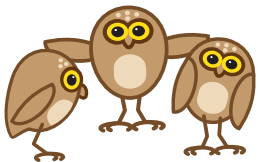
They like to live in family groups.



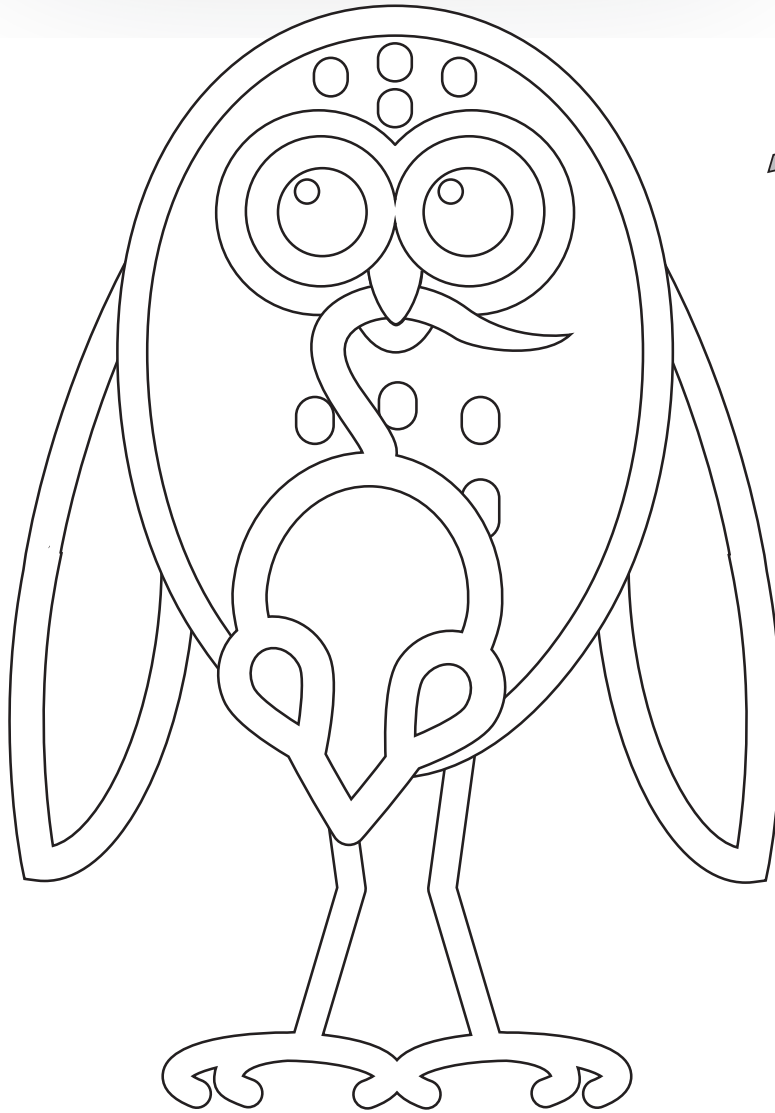
They eat mice, bugs, frogs, lizards, snails and snakes.
