

How Burrowing Owls Use Project Perch's Artificial Burrows

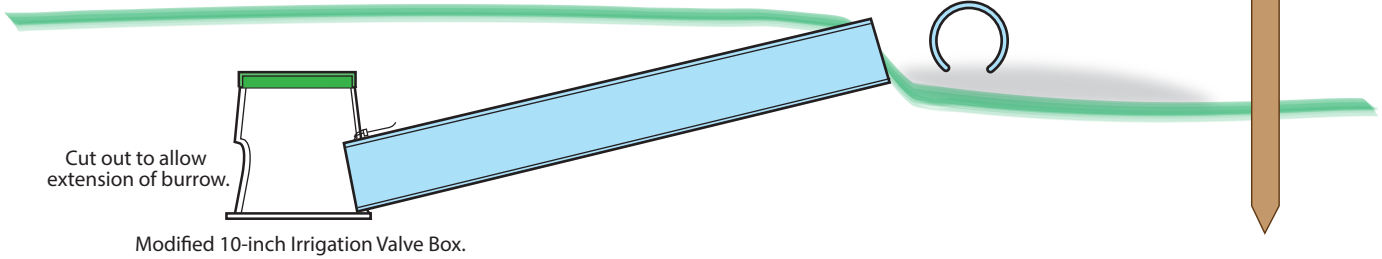
Artificial Burrow as Installed

Cut out to allow extension of burrow.

Modified 10-inch Irrigation Valve Box.

40-inch long, 6-inch diameter pipe with bottom cut out.

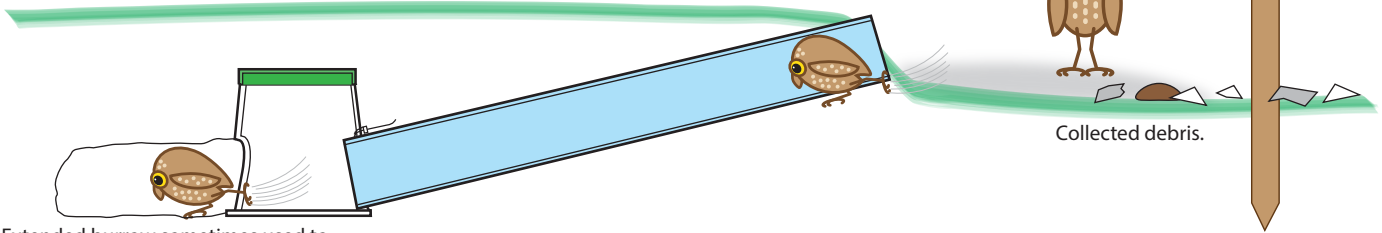
Wooden perch.

Extended burrow sometimes used to store food, like frogs, lizards and mice.

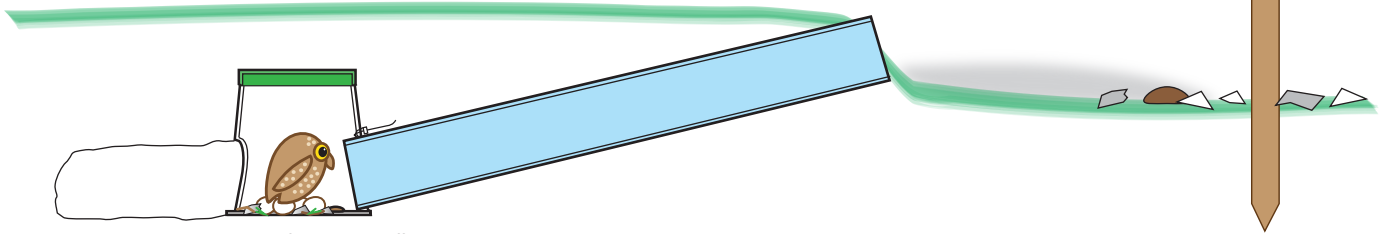
Collected debris.
